Our next client-project is also for school. This will be an academic year planner cover design. There are very little parameters but just like for the Tshirt, consider what imagery would make sense for an Issaquah High School date book/planner. There needs to be some element of imagery as well as the text: "Issaquah High School" and "2020-2021". Optional: "Datebook" or "academic year" etc. Draw 10 thumbnail sketches in portrait (vertical) orientation. You need to show clearly different ideas, not just slight variations on the same idea drawn 10 times. Upload a photo of your sketches to google drive.

### **Thursday-Friday**

Begin executing a final design for the planner cover. Upload a progress picture (screen shot) next Monday for feedback from me. Make sure you are showing a focal point/emphasis.

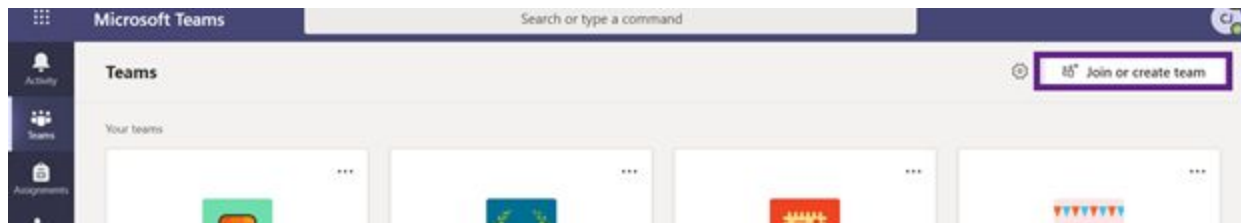
Friday at 10:00 am: live meeting on Microsoft Teams. If you can't be present at that time, you can watch the recording live and send at least one comment to show you watched it.

Note that after this week we will likely be switching over to Microsoft Teams for assignment videos, explanation, and submitting work.
