CLASS POLICIES

• Be H.E.R.E.: Honest - Engaged - Respectful - Empathetic (School-wide initiative)

- Cell phones/devices:
 - NEVER: During teacher instruction
 - SOMETIMES: During student work time. Students are expected to self-manage cell phone
 usage in a responsible and mature way as practice for adulthood. If it becomes a
 distraction from class work it will be required to put it away. You MAY listen to
 headphones during work time but the volume must be low enough that you can still hear,
 and remove them, if I address the class.
 - NEVER: to play games, watch videos, or to take pictures of others. If it becomes a
 distraction from work, I reserve the right to ask you to put your cell phone away or keep it
 at my desk it to help ensure your success in class.

Attendance

- o "Late" = less than 10 min at the beginning OR end of the class period
- o "Tardy" = Missing more than 10 minutes ANY time during the class period
- If you're late or tardy you must come tell me- in order not to be counted absent. I have a lot demanding my attention and may not always notice if you come in late.
- **Leaving class:** Please respect class-time. You must ask before leaving class. Sign in and out on the clipboard under the clock. You may only leave: AFTER the first 10 minutes. BEFORE the last 5 minutes of class. Any errand out of class should be under 10 minutes or you will be marked tardy. If you leave before the bell at the end of class you will be marked late.
- **Responsibility:** As young adults you are expected to be problem solvers and take responsibility for yourself, your ideas, your behavior towards others, cleaning up, being resourceful, etc. Your cleanliness and taking initiative in class will be part of your "Studio Conduct" grade. You should be aware of the location of classroom supplies, your own projects, and turn-in location.
- Communication: I have an open ear to whatever concerns or questions you may have. Please communicate with me in whatever way you feel comfortable (via email, a written note, face to face, etc.). I want my class to be a safe, open space where all voices can be heard. Please wait

- until the middle of class (i.e. after attendance and instruction) to ask questions about grades, past projects, etc.
- **Absences:** If you miss class it is your responsibility to take the initiative to make up work. First check my website for assignments and read written directions there. After that you may ask questions.
- **Seating**: Please stay in your assigned seat except for NECESSARY errands around the room to get materials, etc. This is to minimize chaos and distractions. You are always welcome to come up to my desk to ask questions or get project help.
- New rules or policies may be implemented as needed.
